- What data HEIs gather to support and enhance employability, how the data is used and the fitness for purpose of that data, including how ready we are for Graduate Outcomes, and how we use Destination of Leavers in Higher Education (DLHE) and Longitudinal Educational Outcomes (LEO)
- Evaluating the impact of our employability services and provision; how do we know we are making a difference to the student experience?

The event will aim to produce some draft plans that can be developed to become project bids for funding from QAA Scotland.
